Travel by public transport

- You can get to Bank House by bus and train.
- The nearest bus stop is on Main Street in Winster about 500 yards from the house. Hulleys of Baslow run a regular service between Matlock and Bakewell (Monday to Saturday) . The bus stop is 0.20 miles / 805.0 km from Bank House.
- The nearest train station is Matlock. The train station is 4.2 miles / 6.8 km from Bank House.
- East Midlands Trains operate all trains from Matlock, and London trains from Nottingham, Derby, Chesterfield, and Sheffield.
- You can get a taxi with Als by calling 07866661188.
- You can get a taxi with A1 Taxis by calling 07596 917373.

Parking

- The driveway has parking space for up to 5 cars.

- The drop off and access to the main entrance (the door to the house) is from the parking area. The area is flat, part in part and cobbled. From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is 3000mm wide, or more.
- The entrance to the house and parking is between two stone gate posts. One end is sloped.

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 3000mm wide, or more.

- The main entrance has level access.
- The door is 780mm wide.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, wall lights, bedside lamps, desk or table lamps, spot lights and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 13 steps.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.

- We have bathrooms with a bath and overhead shower. The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the left and right.

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there are 3 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- Plates are white. The table is oak

Sitting room

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there is level access. The route is 1200mm wide, or more. The door is 870mm wide.
- An archway to an inner hall separates the main hallway. this leads to the door to the living room.

TV room

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 4000mm wide, or more.
- The door is 800mm wide.
- The TV room is first room you reach next to the entrance

- From the main entrance to the area, there are 2 steps.
- There are two steps down from the kitchen area through patio doors.

- From the main entrance to the area, there are 25 steps.
- The garden is accessed either by steps from the patio or from a steepish path.
